Vhy?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?	 The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: Social Security number and account balances account transactions and payment history credit scores and credit history
How?	All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons OTS Employees Credit

Union, A Division of Aloha Pacific Federal Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does OTS Employees Credit Union, A Division of Aloha Pacific Federal	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
Credit Union protect my personal information?	We also maintain other physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards to protect this information and limit access to appropriate employees.
How does OTS Employees Credit Union, A Division of Aloha Pacific Federal Credit Union collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you open an account or pay your bills use your credit or debit card or apply for financing make deposits or withdrawals from your account
	We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you
	State law and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

Definitions	
Affiliates	 Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Our affiliates include financial companies, such as Aloha Pacific Federal Credit Union and its Divisions, CU Cooperative Systems Inc., CUSO of Hawaii Investments LLC, CUSO of Hawaii Properties, LLC dba Aloha Pacific Premier Realty, CUSO of Hawaii Services LLC, HICUSO LLC.
Nonaffiliates	 Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. OTS Employees Credit Union, A Division of Aloha Pacific Federal Credit Union does not share with our nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
Joint Marketing	 A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Our joint marketing partners include insurance companies.
